**Did you know that each Buddy Bag contains six meals?** 2 x Breakfast, 2 x Lunch, 2 x Dinner (and snacks). We were packing an average of 540 Buddy Bags each week this past school year for approximately 37 weeks.

 $6 \times 540 = 3,240$  weekly meals.

 $3,240 \times 37 = 119,880$  meals for the school year!

We are looking at serving a greater number of food insecure students this coming school year. With your help!

### The Summer Buddy Bag Program



Once a week for eight weeks during summer break our Buddy bag students' families can come to our warehouse location in Crown Point and shop for groceries.

Food items are arranged according to My Plate specifications and families work with a CHN shopper to choose from various items in the different My Plate categories This year the summer program has been blessed with support from school food drives, \$2,500 from Lions Club District 25A, an anonymous gift of \$2,000 in Aldi gift cards, additional funding from the Crown Point First United Methodist Church and other private donations. This has allowed the purchase of fresh produce through Region Roots which works with local farmers to provide the freshest of local grown produce. We have averaged 39 students per week and there is two weeks left in the summer program.

Then . . . it's full speed ahead for the new school year!!









